**NOTES:**

- 1. The candidates who have applied online can download the admit card to appear in the entrance test from website [www.desgpc.org](http://www.desgpc.org) w.e.f. 12-06-2024.**
  - 2. The Candidates who have not deposited entrance test fee of Rs. 500/- are required to deposit fee at the office of the Directorate of Education on 16-06-2024 before appearing for the test. Failing this candidate shall not be allowed to appear for test.**
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1. Entrance test for admission 2024 shall be held on 16-06-2024 from 10:00 AM to 12:00 Noon (Two Hours Duration) at Nischai Academy for Judicial Services, Directorate of Education, Panth Ratan Jathedar Gurcharan Singh Tohra Institute of Advanced Studies in Sikhism, Bahadurgarh, Patiala. Candidates should report at 9:30 AM sharp on 16-06-2024.
  2. The candidates shall bring his/her id proof and downloaded admit card, issued by Nischai Academy for Judicial Services for appearing in the test.
  3. Test shall be held in two parts, in single sitting. In the first 15 Minutes, the candidates shall attempt 20 objective type questions on Sikh Itihas (ਸਿੱਖ ਇਤਿਹਾਸ) and in remaining 1 hour 45 Minutes to answer 100 objective type questions on Law, General Knowledge and Current Affairs, on OMR Sheets provided with the question booklets.
  4. Before attempting the questions the candidates shall check condition of the question booklets and the OMR Sheets. In case of defect/torn pages/missing text, the candidates can get the sheet replaced. No sheet shall be replaced after the candidates started answering.
  5. The candidates shall shade the circles on the OMR sheet with blue/black ball pen, as answer to the respective question on the question booklet.
  6. The candidates should take care not to fold or mark on any other place on the OMR Sheet except within the circles or space provided for entering Roll Number.
  7. Each objective type questions shall be of 3 marks, there shall be negative marking of 0.5 mark for each wrong answer.
  8. The possession of mobile phone or any kind of electronic gadgets or any other material relating to subjects of test in the examination hall is strictly prohibited.
  9. Use of any form of unfair means shall disqualify the candidate.
  10. Each question shall have four alternative choices as (1), (2), (3) and (4). Out of these one is correct. If more than one answer is indicated, answer will be deemed to be incorrect.
  11. On completion of test, candidate must hand over the OMR Answer sheet and question booklets to the invigilator.
